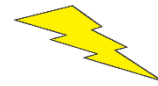

School Power Issue



Dear College Community.

No doubt you will all have heard of the power outages at the College. This has proven to be at the least frustrating through to potentially impacting on our capacity to manage the school and students safely.

The outages have been caused by the College draw on power exceeding fuse capacity and so it is highlighting a number of issues for the Board.

We are awaiting an updated quote to install a transformer and update the feed line that will ensure we have ample supply into the future. This is unlikely to take place before next term.

We have also been working to understand better our draw and how we can manage this so that we will not compromise supply through main supply fuses blowing. We have learned a considerable amount and have established some practices that should mean we will not experience another disruption in supply through until a new transformer is installed.

Across the school we need to be very 'power conscious' and discipline our draw in the interim to maintain supply and into the longer term to be more disciplined to keep our winter bills to a reasonable level.

Thanks to everyone for your ongoing support through this time.
