



Principal's Comment



Tenā koutou katoa e te whānau whānui,

As we settle into school life halfway through Term 1 it is important to ensure our students continue to do the basics well so that they can maximise their opportunities at the college. As always, all we ask of our students is to attend on time, organised and prepared for learning and we will do the rest. We all know and understand the importance of regular attendance and the connection between this and success. The Ministry of Education has introduced some new terms regarding attendance. Through the Stepped Attendance Response (STAR). These are:

Good (good chance of success): less then 5 days absence in a school term
Worrying (less chance of success) up to 10 days of absence in a school term
Concerning (hard to make progress) up to 15 days absence in a school term
Serious Concern (very hard to make progress) 15 days or more absence in a school term

Our expectations for student attendance:

Regular attendance at school is important to your child's success and there is a clear connection between going to school regularly and doing well in the classroom. Making sure students attend and engage in learning is a shared responsibility. As a parent, you are responsible for making sure your child attends school every day. If your child is going to be absent for any reason it is essential that you let us know as soon as possible. It is important that you phone us/send us an email/message us to confirm your child's absence and provide us with the reason. We acknowledge that there are genuine reasons students may occasionally be absent. However, without regular attendance your child will struggle to make progress. If your child is absent regularly, or for extended periods, we will reach out to you to discuss the situation. We are committed to supporting your child to attend school.
